Curt and Carol Fischer, the owners of Missouri Medical Clinic, opened their doors in December of 2022, just a few months after the semaglutide compound first was approved to be made. They were met with an overwhelmingly positive response from the community.

"The medication works by targeting GLP-1 receptors in the brain to regulate appetite and food intake. It also mimics the action of the natural GLP-1 hormone by increasing insulin release and delaying the stomach emptying. This controls appetite and helps to reduce food consumption."



"Patients do not get as hungry, and they eat and think about food less, along with experiencing reduced cravings. The simple end-result is losing weight. When Ozempic was approved by the FDA for weight loss, the manufacturer Novo Nordisc started calling the weight loss version semaglutide-Wegovy. "We see imported Chinese powder all over the Internet, spas, and even other clinics... This is exactly why our patients like dealing with a real brick and mortar clinic and people they can get to know and connect with for answers when needed," Carol explained. "We often monitor texts and Facebook questions or comments after hours. All compounds are not equal. We provide safer and stronger semaglutide and tirxepatide generic compounds."

"There is a world-wide shortage of Ozempic right now," Curt said. "By offering the generic compound, that the FDA has approved to be made, we can help with this name brand shortage. Fewer people will be chasing after the brand name medication that Type-2 diabetics need. Insurance companies are paying as high

as \$1600/month for their insured diabetics to be on Ozempic and Mounjaro. Unfortunately, that is exactly how Big Pharma works."

"The compound is helping fill this shortage which directly benefits our weight loss patients with a cost-effective alternative to the expensive brands Ozempic, Mounjaro diabetic meds and Wegovy and Zepbound, their weight loss product equivalents. The active ingredients are either semaglutide or tirzepatide. The name brand shortages are not for the actual medication but rather the two pharmaceutical companies just cannot keep up with the demand. So, the fat shaming trolls on the internet and our Facebook page who are criticizing taking the compounded medication for weight loss are totally missing the point of who needs this miracle drug. Obesity is a disease and the number one cause of Type 2 diabetes."


While insurance does not cover semaglutide or tirzepatide compounds for weight loss, <u>Missouri Medical Clinic</u> offers the semaglutide compound treatment for under \$300 on a month-month plan and even lower than \$200 for multi-milliliter (multi-month) vials. There is Free 0% financing available on their website so people can take advantage of the volume discounts they offer.
